Give Thoughtful Feedback	Continuously listened to others in the group and responded with comments that were helping the group to make the product better. Respect Others and Their Thoughts	Always respected other group members and never gave rude or inappropriate responses. Use Soft Voices	Consistently used a quiet voice during all times that were expected and reminded others to do the same. Participate Actively	Almost always listens to, shares with, and supports the efforts of others. Tries to keep people working well together.	Usually listens to, shares, with, and supports the efforts of others. Does not cause "waves" in the group.	Often listens to, shares with, and supports the efforts of others, but sometimes is not a good team member.	Rarely listens to, shares with, and supports the efforts of others. Often is not a good team player.
Stays With Group	Stayed with group during all work times and held other people accountable for staying with the group.	Stayed with group nearly all the time. Wandered away from the group only 1 or 2 times.	Left the group enough times that the members of the group would get frustrated that it slowed down progress.	Was with the group less than half the time and had to be reminded by the group members much of the time.
